Paws, Ears, & Horns - six hour workshop

Let your imagination take flight! This workshop is aimed at anyone who makes or aspires to make non-human, hybrid, or fantasy figures.

In this workshop I will show you

- different options for making animal and bird feet
- different kinds of animal/faery ears
- Tips and tricks for making convincing horns

This workshop is best for anyone who has already taken my workshop *Making Faces*. In this intensive workshop you will learn how to make different animal and bird feet, including considerations for making a standing figure. You will be able to experiment with making different kinds of animal/fantasy ears (including hare, faun, faery) and I will show you how to make realistic-looking horns. Make as many as you like during the day.

We will be working in clay but please note, your pieces will NOT be fired: instead, you will be able to take them home with you at the end of the day and use them as reference and inspiration to realise your own vision, taking what you have learned to create your own amazing figures! Clay may not ultimately even be your preferred medium - but it is soft and easy to work and therefore perfect for an intensive day of honing your sculpting skills to the max.

This workshop is perfect for anyone who wants to make masks, jointed figures, dolls, puppets, or busts. Please note: it is NOT a life sculpting class - you will be encouraged to work from the imagination and develop your own style.

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
